#### 1) Scheme of Examination

#### 2) Syllabus of Examinations

**Paper -1** (Objective type)- General English and General Hindi covering Synonyms, Articles, Tenses, Vocabulary, Spelling Test, prepositions in respective languages etc., No. of questions 100 each i.e 200 Questions with 200 marks of 2 Hrs duration. Each question carries 01 mark and there will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer in Paper I

**Paper 2** (Descriptive and conventional type) – 200 marks

- i) Translation from English to Hindi and Hindi to English and
- ii) Essay writing on English and Hindi, using paper and pen mode.

3) Level of Examinations:

The level of Question papers will be consistent with the educational qualifications prescribed for the post of Junior Hindi Translator (JHT)

4) Merit Determination

a) Qualifying Criteria

Paper 1: Atleast 50% in each of the Section (General English  
And General Hindi)

Paper II: Atleast 50% for paper II

b) Merit preparation : Rank list would be prepared based on the combined marks (Paper-I & Paper-II) list from those candidates satisfying or meeting the above qualifying criteria

5) All the candidates are advised to bring original admit cards while coming for the written examination and they have to affix recent passport size colour photo identical to the photo affixed on application form and requested to keep a photocopy of admit card since the original one will be collected at the time of written exam.

6) Provisionally admitted candidates, will be allowed to enter the test Centre only on production of admit cards and photocopy of deficient documents, as mentioned in the admit cards, before commencement of written test, at certificate verification cell located in the venue, failing which they will not be permitted for written exam.

7) Please carry Government issued photo identity card (i.e PAN Card/Aadhar/Driving license, etc) as a proof of your identity in the examination hall.

8) Use of blue or black ball point pen only is allowed in the written test.

9) No mobile phone/Scanning device/any electronic gadget shall be allowed in the test centre. No arrangement for storing these items shall be provided at the test centre.

10) No Travelling expenses will be admissible for written test.

11) Admit cards for the eligible candidates have already despatched through speed post in their correspondence addresses, as mentioned in the application forms and emails have also sent.
